The story must be a maximum 500 words and the poem must be a maximum of 20 lines.

Your story/poem should be submitted typed on a single side of A4. Drawings should be submitted on A4.

Entries will be judged and prizes awarded in the following categories:-

6 years and under – drawing

7 years – 11 years – poem

7 years – 11 years – story

Competition closes on Friday 8 September 2017.

Winners and runners-up will be announced and read/displayed in the Storytelling tent at the Wortwell Silver Festival event on Saturday 16 September at Wortwell Community Centre from Midday.

Selected stories and poems will be published in a book which will be available to purchase in the future.
